OVERVIEW

Reflecting our Heavenly Father's call to all His children to seek forgiveness when one has sinned against others and to live in peace with others in our community, the Angel Tree Project (ATP) is our annual signature event under Seventy Times Seven (70x7), the IPC fund of PFS.

The primary objective of the ATP is to instill the hope of restoring broken relations with loved ones, hence this project creates the opportunity for inmates to pen their letters containing messages seeking forgiveness and reconciliation with their family members.

With the support of volunteers from churches across Singapore, these letters are hand delivered, accompanied with grocery vouchers sponsored by our supporters, to the various families, with the deliveries taking place in December to bring Christmas cheer to the recipients.

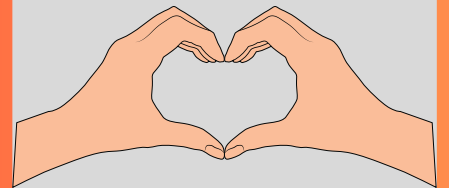
